## PRESIDENT'S CORNER

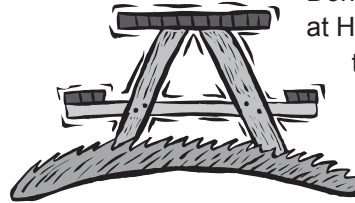
Greetings SSC Members! Spring may be in the air, but the Board, the Trip Committee and our trip leaders are busy planning next season's ski trips. For example, in an effort to encourage sales of this year's trips in the current economic climate, the Board has decided to implement these Trip Committee recommendations **on a trial basis**:

1. The Board has given the Executive Committee the authority to immediately expand trips, if possible, when the response to a trip is overwhelming. We feel this will allow us to respond much more quickly to members' demand for our trips.
2. We are suspending the use of co-leaders on larger trips. We feel this will help decrease the overall cost of the trip, but will also require cooperation by the trip participants in aiding the trip leader whenever necessary.
3. Land-only spots will be sold at the start of trip sales. Previously we only sold the "land-onlies" after all air seats were sold. Some changes we have made to pricing will allow us to try this approach to trip sales.
4. Any cancellation or change from the initial application to a major trip will incur a minimum \$25 penalty. In the past we have encountered a rash of participants dropping off trips the day before the cancellation fees are instituted, requiring the trip leader quickly to fill these spots so the trip does not incur resort cancellation fees.

With these temporary polices in place, we are optimistic that despite the economy, SSC members will still be able to enjoy the quality trip experience they have come to expect. Don't forget to bring a dish to share! If you forget, you will be asked to make an additional contribution of \$2 per person.

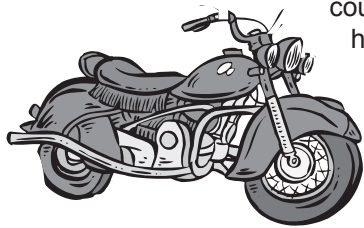

## YELLOW BREECHES FLOAT TRIP Sunday, June 28



Bring, borrow or buy a boat and come spend a lazy day paddling the Yellow Breeches Creek with us on Sunday afternoon, June 28. Don't worry, just in case you are among the last people to leave the SSC picnic on Saturday evening, you'll still have plenty of time to get rested up before meeting us at 12 noon at the old historic covered bridge at Messiah College in Grantham.

Kayaks, canoes or large sturdy inner tubes are the recommended boats of choice for this float. There are no rentals available at the site, so you must provide your own gear, including PFDs, whistles, sunscreen, water bottles and snacks. This creek is spring-fed and usually has good water levels throughout the summer, so, as long as the weather cooperates that day, we'll go about 9 miles to the Lower Allen Park at Moore's Mountain Road. Allow several hours for the float itself and time to shuttle vehicles to and from the take-out.

**Directions from the McDonald's parking lot at Rtes. 15 & 114:** turn south onto Bumble Bee Hollow Road, turn right onto West Lisburn Road and take a left into Messiah College at Grantham Road. Turn right onto College Avenue and follow this around the buildings until you see the covered bridge crossing the creek to the athletic fields. 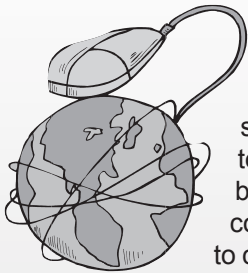
