IT'S THAT TIME AGAIN ~ MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL INFORMATION

SSC's new membership year begins April 1 and we urge you to renew your membership today so you don't miss any of our great events or a chance to sign up for our trips. You now have lots of choices in how to renew your SSC membership:

- 1) You can personally hand in a completed membership application form found in this newsletter with your check for a year's membership dues at the registration desk at the last membership meeting of the year on March 3.
- 2) You can mail a completed membership application form and your check for a year's membership dues to the address provided on that form.
- 3) Or most convenient to you, you can renew your membership online. To this end, each current SSC member will receive an email from the club around March 18 to facilitate your online renewal process. If you don't renew within a week of receiving that email, you'll receive another reminder email around March 25. Members who haven't renewed before April 1 will receive another email on that date, and following this we have two final reminders set to go out 30 days and 90 days after April 1 to members who have not renewed by those dates. All of these emails include a link to our website and directions for logging on and completing the renewal process. If you forgot your password, a link is provided in these emails to obtain a new temporary password. The first part of the membership renewal process includes reviewing your contact information in our member records. If you need to update your contact information to reflect a new email address, mailing address or telephone number, this is the time to make the changes. (*Just click on the "Edit Profile" button at the top of your profile page to make changes.*) When you're ready to complete the process, click on the "Renew until April 1, 2016" button. This will initiate a membership dues payment loop, where you have the option of paying your dues by mailing in a check, by paying with your PayPal account, or by paying your dues with a debit or credit card.

Special note for our lifetime members: although you have been awarded a free lifetime membership in our club, we like to hear from our lifetime members at least once a year to ensure we don't lose touch with you. Our lifetime members are included in the series of emails to our members that will launch on March 18. If you respond early to one of these emails, you won't hear from us again except for email newsletters and email blasts for another full year!
